Visual Confirmation

Emphasise the importance of visually confirming that all car doors are locked, rather than solely relying on the key fob, to ensure the vehicle's security.



Physical Deterrents

Highlight the effectiveness of physical deterrents such as steering locks in preventing thieves from driving off with the car, even in the event of successful unauthorised access.



Tracking Devices

Explain the potential benefits of investing in a tracking device to increase the chances of locating and recovering a stolen vehicle.



Valuables Protection

Advise customers to avoid leaving valuable items on display in the car and instead store them in the glove box or remove them from the vehicle, especially overnight.



Insurance Coverage Review

Remind customers to review their car insurance policy to understand the coverage provided in the event of keyless car theft and ensure it meets their needs.
